Clinical research summary

To compare clinical equivalence across NPWT devices, Dr. Lawrence Lavery, DPM, MPH at UT Southwestern, performed a randomized clinical study, funded by Cardinal Health. The study found no significant difference in clinical outcomes or adverse events when comparing NPWT devices¹.
