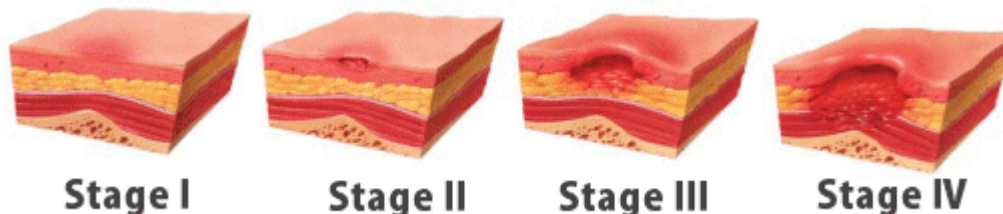




Grove Medical Advanced Wound Care Product Guide



Stage I-

Clean: Skin Cleanser

Protect: Skin Protectant

Stage II-

Clean: Wound Cleanser

Protect: Skin Protectant

Cover: Non-draining to Minimal Drainage ~Transparent Film Dressing

Minimal to Moderate Drainage ~Hydrocolloid (thin or standard)

Moderate to Heavy Drainage ~Adhesive Foam or Non-adhesive Foam

Sacral Ulcer: Hydrocolloid

Stage III/IV-

Clean: Wound Cleanser

Protect: Skin Protectant

Fill: Dry to Minimal Drainage ~Gel Wound Filler

Moderate to Heavy Drainage ~Calcium Alginate Wound Filler

Cover:

Non-draining to Minimal Drainage ~Transparent Film with Non-Adherent Pad

Minimal to Moderate Drainage with Minimal Depth ~Hydrocolloid

Moderate to Heavy Drainage ~Foam Dressing (Adhesive or Non-adhesive)

Unstageable Pressure Ulcer-

Clean: Wound Cleanser

Protect: Skin Protectant

Cover: See cover dressing choices noted under Stage III/IV for management of exudates level.

NOTE: Debridement of ulcers with devitalized tissue is necessary. Notify MD/Wound Consultant for debridement options.

Stable (dry, adherent, intact without erythema or fluctuance) eschar on the heels serves as “the body’s natural (biological) cover” and SHOULD NOT be removed.

Suspected Deep Tissue Injury-

Clean: Wound Cleanser

Protect: Skin Protectant



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
